Facing death is a subject rarely confronted, although more people are now asking for information. Raising an awareness of the choices at the end of life is increasingly important as medical science provides more options for dealing with incurable illness.

Helen has shown us a way here. She talked to many, if not most, of her family and friends, about the different stages of her illness. The story, *Soror*, takes us to her end.

As a memorial to her, all proceeds of this limited keepsake edition will be donated to a Trust Fund within the Kangaroo Island Health Service- Palliative Care, overseen by Sharon Clark, Community Health Nurse.
